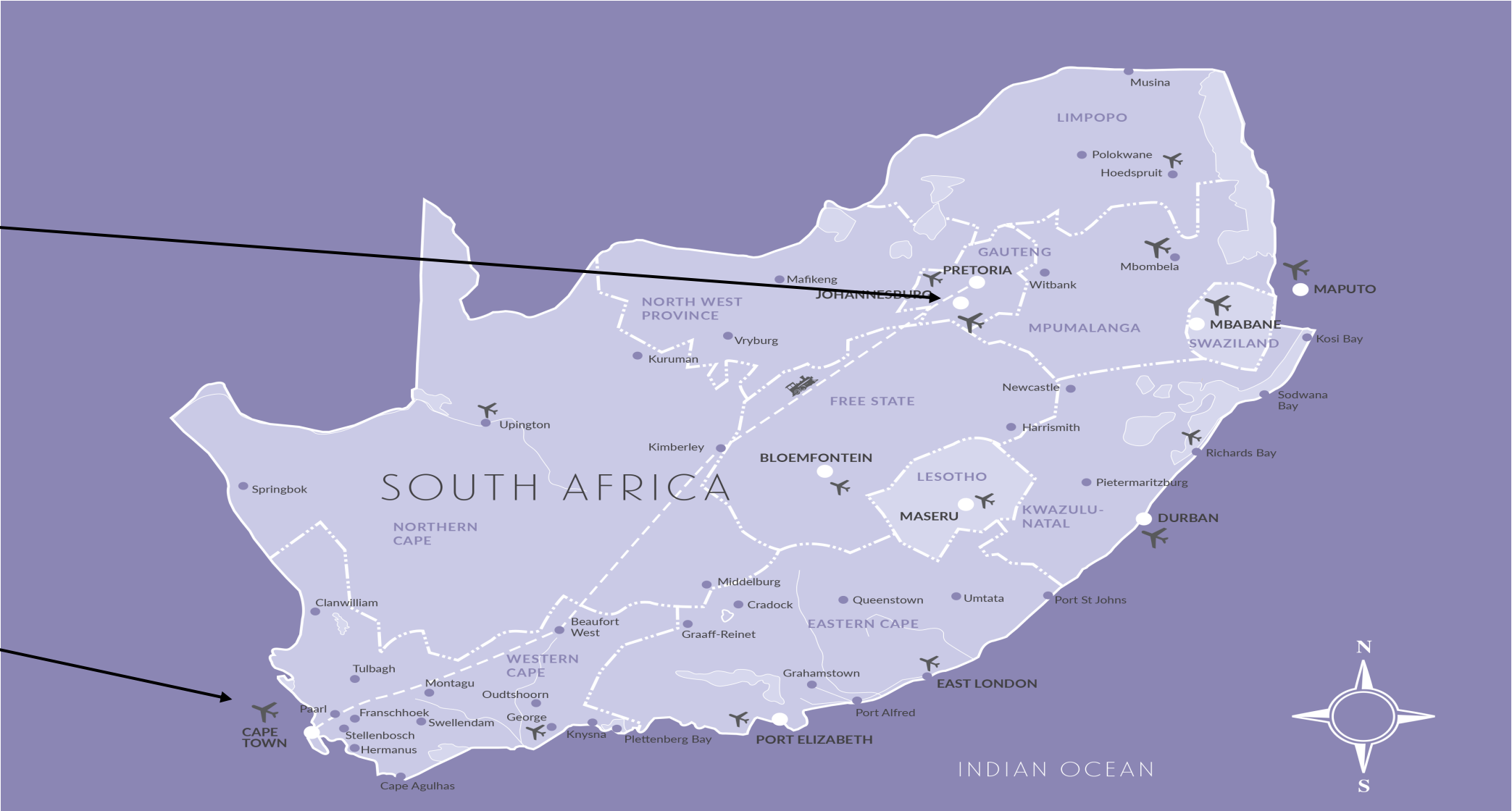


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MAP | South Africa

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DAY 1: Arrival in Johannesburg



On arrival at OR Tambo International Airport you are met by a Luzuko representative who will assist you with your luggage and escort you to your vehicle where you will meet your guide and driver and be transferred to your Hotel for check-in.

Arrival drinks will be served whilst the guide proceeds with checking you in at the Hotel.

The rest of the day to be enjoyed at your own leisure.

Optional: City Orientation Tour of Pretoria

Dinner can be arranged at a restaurant of your choice. We recommend Asanka Restaurant a South African dining experience with a menu filled with local flavours and a wide collection of SA wines.

DAY 2: Sandton, Johannesburg and Soweto | Lesedi



Breakfast is enjoyed at the hotel before we depart on a full day of culture and history of South Africa.

We explore the city of Johannesburg and visit Soweto – the place which symbolizes the fight for freedom. Relive the history as we journey through the rise and fall of apartheid during the 20th century.

Lunch is enjoyed in the heart of Soweto in Vilakazi Street.

Lesedi is located in the heart of the African bushveld amidst the rocky hills within the Cradle of Humankind, a World Heritage Site. Discover the fascinating cultures and traditions of the people of Africa, visiting five traditional homesteads inhabited by Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi, Basotho and Ndebele tribes who live according to tribal folklore and traditions of their ancestors.

Dinner is enjoyed at the Village with a mix of local and European inspired foods. Enjoy the feast with some cultural dancing and singing.

DAY 3: Sun City Resort



Breakfast at enjoyed at the hotel before we depart on a drive to Sun City in the North West province – approx. 2 hours by road.

The extraordinary Sun City Resort is internationally recognised as the ultimate African Experience. Well-known on the international golf circuit for the incomparable Nedbank Golf Challenge and famous for the Lost City, fabled to be the ruins of a glorious ancient civilisation, which celebrates and resurrects the legends of a mystical past in its glorious architecture and myriad entertainment features.

Spend the afternoon at The Valley of the Waves or enjoy water sports on the resorts large lake.

Dinner is enjoyed in one of the many restaurants and then perhaps the casino and try your luck at gambling.

DAY 4: Pilanesberg Safari



Breakfast and some time at leisure before your short transfer to your lodge in the Pilanesberg National Park.

Pilanesberg National Park is in the Bojanala Region of the North West Province, adjacent to Sun City. The Park, which covers some 55 000 hectare, is the fourth largest in southern Africa. This malaria free park is perched on the eroded vestiges of an alkaline volcanic crater, one of only three such craters in the world. Pilanesberg exists within the transition zone between the dry Kalahari and wetter Lowveld vegetation, commonly referred to as "Bushveld". Unlike any other large park, unique overlaps of mammals, birds and vegetation occur because of this transition zone.

Late afternoon, depart on the safari game drive. During the drive, stop and enjoy sundowner drinks in the bush.

DINNER: Guests will be surprised with a private bush dinner this evening, with a Marimba band and energetic tribal dance show. Engage in interactive drumming and busking with local dancers & singers from the surrounding community as fall asleep to the sounds of the African bush.

DAY 5: Cape Town “Mother City”



An early morning call from the Ranger will wake you before first light, enjoy a cup of coffee or tea and so begins the morning safari. The bush is already alive, the air filled with birdsong as the rising sunlight dances off beads of dew on spiders' webs.

Returning to the lodge enjoy a scrumptious breakfast, before departing by road for Johannesburg to board your 2 hour flight to Cape Town.

On arrival in Cape Town this evening embark on a private sunset cruise, while sipping a glass of sparkling wine. The Mirage 760 is the newest jewel in the Mother City's crown. Look forward to experiencing thrill of the open water, the bliss of world-class luxury, and the awe-inspiring beauty of Cape Town at her finest.

Dinner is enjoyed with a barbeque on board with a private DJ.

DAY 6: Winelands and Wine Tasting

We recommend dinner at Round House in the Constantia Valley.

DAY 7: Cape Point with Funicular and Penguin Colony



Breakfast is enjoyed at the hotel before we depart for your full day Cape Peninsula excursion. We start on a scenic transfer to Cape Point via Sea Point, with a stop over at Hout Bay one of the oldest harbours in Cape Town. Enjoying a trip to seal island via a boat trip before we continue on our journey. Making our way through Chapman's Peak past the Twelve Apostles on route to Cape Point.

Lunch is enjoyed at Two Oceans Restaurant at Cape Point

The afternoon travel to Boulders Beach and a close up walking experience amongst the resident penguins. Scenic transfer back to your hotel in the later afternoon via the Naval town of Simon's Town and brightly coloured bathing beach houses at Muizenberg.

Farewell dinner this evening at GOLD African Restaurant with interactive drumming (6 pm): From the moment you walk through the glass doors into the Restaurant, it will take you on a taste safari from Cape Malay to African cuisine. A soothing hand washing ceremony will begin your dining experience, followed by your African feast.

DAY 8: Depart Cape Town

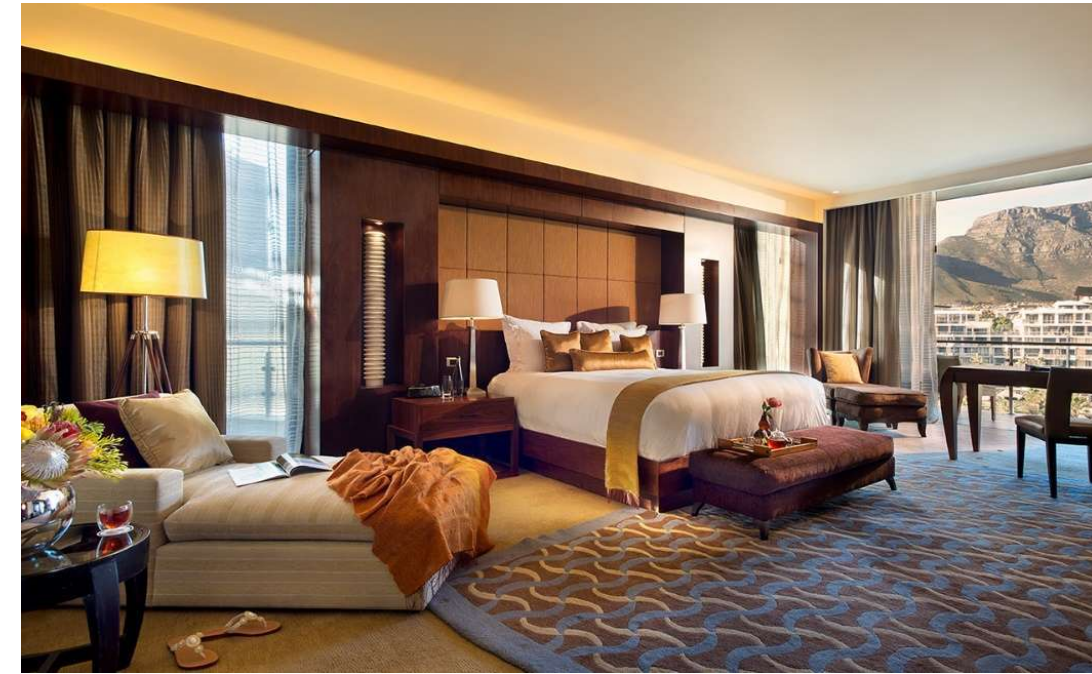
