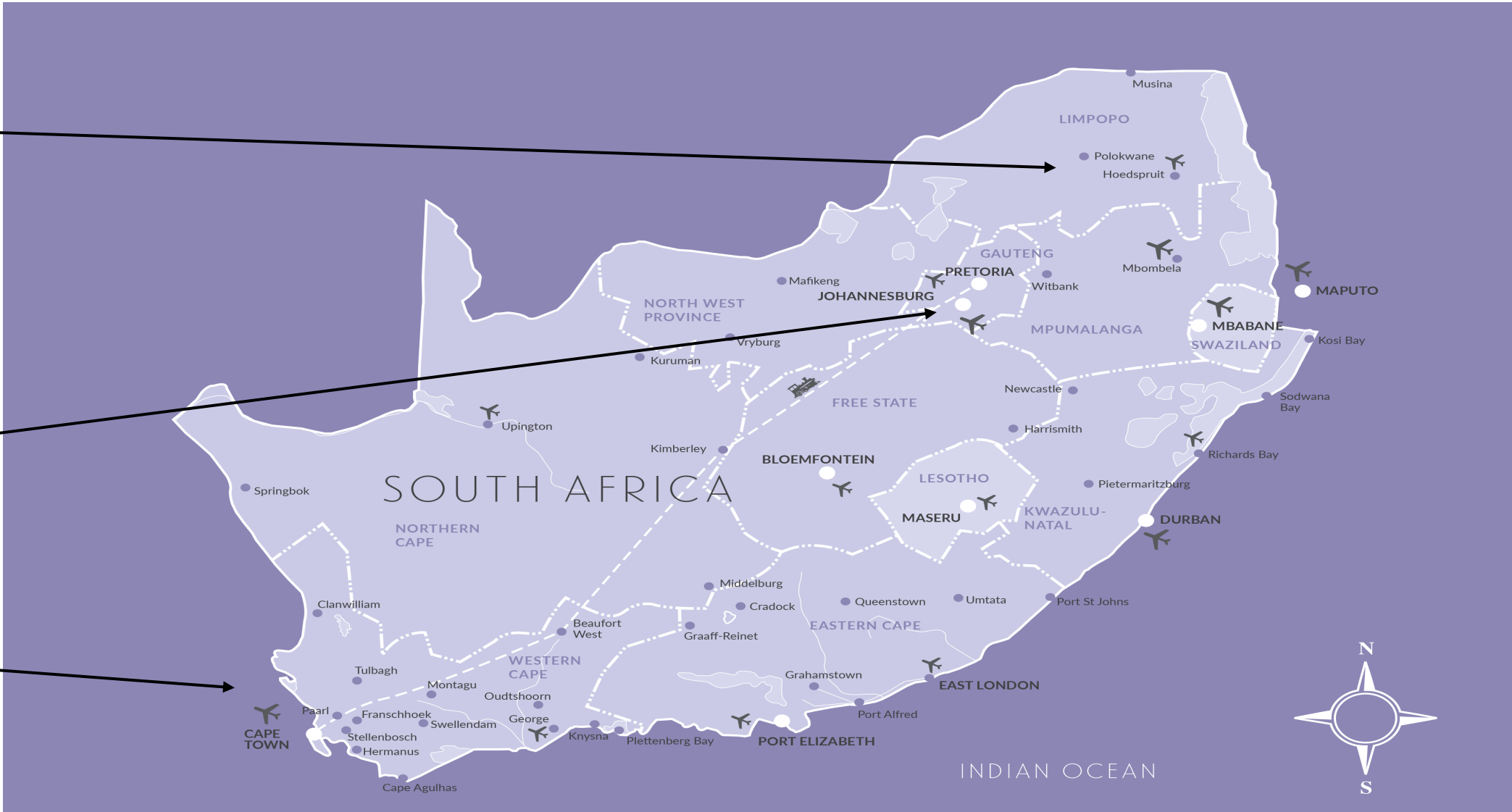

DAY 1: Arrival in Johannesburg - Kruger National Park



Arrival at OR Tambo International Airport you are met by a Luzuko representative who will assist you with a to domestic departures. Here you will board a 1 hour flight to Hoedspruit.
Short road transfer to your private lodge, Kapama Private Game Reserve.

Lodge staff will meet you on arrival with lemon scented warm towels and sparkling wine. Afternoon tea, followed by a game drive in open vehicles: Trackers sit up at the front of the Land Rover looking for fresh animal tracks, while rangers drive with astonishing skill into ravines and through thicket in pursuit of elusive animals, simultaneously wowing guests with their outstanding knowledge and unforgettable stories. Allow the field guides to wow you with their safari know how, move you with their stories, and bring you one step closer to nature. In the evening, your eyes are in for a feast as well. Drink in the winter skyline; looking out for those postcard images – the bare thorn tree standing stark against the shimmering red of the sinking sun as the black of night approaches from behind you.

Boma dinner at River Lodge with a local choir. Every ingredient is chosen with care, favouring home grown organic produce, free range game and herbs from the kitchen garden to create dishes that are irresistibly delicious and healthy.

DAY 2: Kruger National Park Safari



Rise with the dawn for your early morning Game Drive. This South African Game Reserve provides an authentic, intimate safari experience, boasting amazing wildlife viewing, in the wild African bush, whilst retaining all the luxuries and comforts of en-suite facilities and home-from-home lodging.

Experienced rangers and trackers will take you on an exciting bush adventure. Return for breakfast at your Lodge.

Morning at leisure - optional activities : bush walking expeditions, centre for endangered animals, cultural village visit, hot air ballooning & SPA/wellness centre

At lodge you enjoy lunch, followed by a late afternoon game drive with sundowner drinks stop.

Private bush dinner, under the stars, with a local Shangaan choir. Savour meat cooked on an open fire, pots with various local delicacies and energetic entertainment with traditional dancers. Feel the beat of their drum and the rhythm of their dancing.

DAY 3: God's Window and Blyde River Canyon



An early morning game drive is a richly rewarding experience. Witnessing the start of the day in the African bush is like being invited to partake in a daily miracle. A dawn chorus of birdsong and the haunting calls of fish eagles, the air rich with the night flowers' perfume and delightfully cool.

Enjoy your final morning game drive before returning to the lodge for breakfast.

Road transfer back to Johannesburg with one of the most amazing views as we pass God's Window and drive along the Blyde River Canyon. Lunch is enjoyed on route.

Dinner is enjoyed at Pigalle's Restaurant when we have arrived in the Sandton.

DAY 4: Sandton, Johannesburg and Soweto | Lesedi



Breakfast is enjoyed at the hotel before we depart on a full day of culture and history of South Africa.

We explore the city of Johannesburg and visit Soweto – the place which symbolizes the fight for freedom. Relive the history as we journey through the rise and fall of apartheid during the 20th century.

Lunch is enjoyed in the heart of Soweto in Vilakazi Street.

Lesedi is located in the heart of the African bushveld amidst the rocky hills within the Cradle of Humankind, a World Heritage Site. Discover the fascinating cultures and traditions of the people of Africa, visiting five traditional homesteads inhabited by Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi, Basotho and Ndebele tribes who live according to tribal folklore and traditions of their ancestors.

Dinner is enjoyed at the Village with a mix of local and European inspired foods. Enjoy the feast with some cultural dancing and singing.

DAY 5: Cape Town “Mother City”



Breakfast is enjoyed at the Hotel and after we departure and after we depart for OR Tambo International Airport and assist you to Domestic Departures. Here you will board a 2 hour flight to Cape Town

Arrival at Cape Town International Airport you are met by a Luzuko representative who will assist you to your vehicle. We depart for Table Mountain, ascend via a five-minute cable car trip to the top, 1 089 meters above Cape Town, and explore the summit. As we descend into the bustling streets and brightly coloured houses of the Bo-Kaap, located above the city, for a delicious local lunch - tuck into a Cape Malay selection of samosas and sweet treats like koeksisters and milk tart and visit to Atlas Spice Trading to shop for spices to take home.

This evening we embark on a private sunset cruise, while sipping a glass of sparkling wine. The Mirage 760 is the newest jewel in the Mother City's crown. Look forward to experiencing thrill of the open water, the bliss of world-class luxury, and the awe-inspiring beauty of Cape Town at her finest.

Dinner is enjoyed with a barbeque on board with a private DJ.

DAY 6: Winelands and Wine Tasting



Breakfast is enjoyed at the Hotel and after we departure for full day Cape Winelands excursion. The fertile green valleys of the Cape Winelands are surrounded by proud mountain ranges.

- Stellenbosch, tree lined streets, historical architecture, alfresco cafés and good shopping.

- Cape Dutch architecture & wine tasting on some of the finest Cape Wine Estates: Anthonij Rupert, Boschendal, Plaisir de Merle, Delaire, Ernie Els, Vrede en Lust. Lunch is enjoyed at Boschendal Estate with a leisurely picnic lunch.

We recommend dinner at Round House in the Constantia Valley.

DAY 7: Cape Point with Funicular and Penguin Colony



Breakfast at enjoyed at the hotel before we depart for your full day Cape Peninsula excursion. We start on a scenic transfer to Cape Point via Sea Point, with a stop over at Hout Bay one of the oldest harbours in Cape Town. Enjoying a trip to seal island via a boat trip before we continue on our journey. Making our way through chapman's peak past the twelve apostles on route to Cape Point.

Lunch is enjoyed at Two Oceans Restaurant at Cape Point

The afternoon travel to Boulders Beach and a close up walking experience amongst the resident penguins. Scenic transfer back to your hotel in the later afternoon via the Naval town of Simon's Town and brightly coloured bathing beach houses at Muizenberg.

Farewell dinner this evening at GOLD African Restaurant with interactive drumming (6 pm): From the moment you walk through the glass doors into the Restaurant, it will take you on a taste safari from Cape Malay to African cuisine. A soothing hand washing ceremony will begin your dining experience, followed by your African feast.

DAY 8: Depart Cape Town
